How Does Music Make Us Feel?

Music can make us feel lots of different emotions. How? With a mix of rhythm and tempo, note and pitch.

Rhythm and Tempo

Rhythm is the number and pattern of beats in music. When we clap our hands or play the drums, we make a rhythm. A good rhythm makes us want to get up and move.

The tempo of music is the speed of the beat. It is how fast or slow the music is. A slow tempo can make us feel relaxed. A fast tempo can make us feel excited.

Why? Because of the tempo of our heartbeats. When we are excited, our heartbeat goes up. So music with fast tempos can make us feel excited.

Note and Pitch

A note is a sound we make when we make music. This sound has a high or low pitch. Pitch is how high or low a sound is. A whistle has a high pitch.

The roar of a lion has a low pitch. Music in a high pitch can make us feel happy. Music in a low pitch can make us feel sad.
