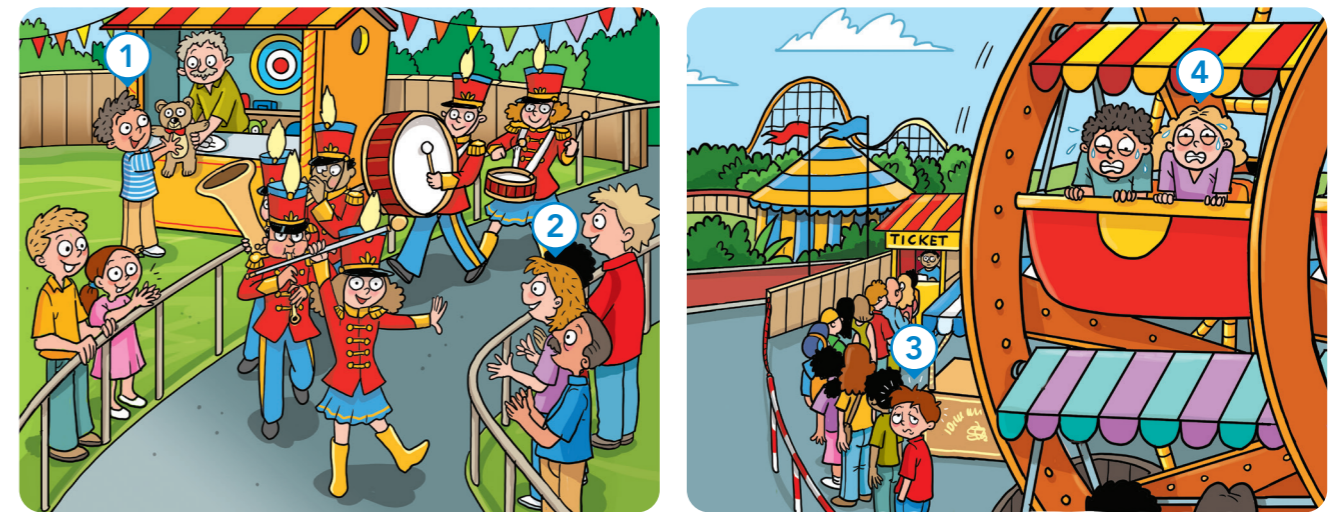

Rhythm and Tempo

Rhythm is the number and pattern of beats in music. When we clap our hands or play the drums, we make a rhythm.

A good _____ makes us want to get up and move.

The tempo of music is the speed of the _____. It is how fast or slow the music is. A slow tempo can make us feel relaxed. A fast tempo can make us feel excited.

Why? Because of the tempo of our heartbeats. When we are excited, our heartbeat goes up. So music with fast _____ can make us feel excited.

Note and Pitch
